

## Adult Education Opportunities

Adult Education classes will begin on Sunday, Sept. 18<sup>th</sup>. Classes for adults will take place on Sunday mornings (between services) as well as Sunday evenings from 6:30-8:00.

Sunday mornings (9:45-10:45) – Topics Class led (initially) by Shannon Mudd. Each week a different biblical topic will be introduced for discussion. Drop-ins are welcome and encouraged! This class meets in the library.

Sunday mornings (9:45-10:45) The Present Word Bible Study, led by Bud Lee. The theme for the fall is “You Will Be My Witnesses” and the group will be reading and discussing the Book of Acts. This class meets in the Parlor.

Cindy will lead an exploration of the power of speech and consider how we can learn to speak with grace. A companion book will be available, but not required.

Sunday evenings (6:30-8:00), Sept. 18 – Oct. 30 – Galatians. Leader: Sue Casey
